1 CHARGES AND REMISSIONS FOR PARENTS

All pupil places at Peterhouse are funded through fees paid by Local Authorities. These cover all aspects of the school's provision, including:

- Community access
- Educational visits
- Sporting activities
- Lunchtime clubs
- School lunches

In exceptional circumstances, a voluntary contribution may be requested from parents for an extra-curricular activity. These contributions will always be voluntary and pupil participation will not be dependent on a contribution being made.

Parents are asked to provide suitable clothing for activities e.g. waterproof coats and sturdy footwear for Forest School or Duke of Edinburgh activities. Parents who may find it difficult to provide these are asked to contact the school, as some clothing and equipment can be lent by school.

2 MONITORING AND REVIEW

This policy will be reviewed by the School Business Leader every 3 years, or sooner if there are any changes to the school's provision which might result in a charge to parents. Any changes that cover charges to parents will be approved by the Education Services Governance Committee.
